Auchtermairnie charges the standard weekly fee at Fife Councils approved rate and that applies to all residents whether self funded or Fife Council funded. With the exception of Rooms 6 & 19 which are double rooms and may incur an extra charge if let as a single.

The fee changes yearly normally in April, for current fee levels please refer to the residents Information Pack.

Your fee covers all care, accommodation and food costs as well as a detailed activity programme.

Additional charges apply for all external services, i.e. Day Trips, Outings, Hairdressing, Newspapers, Escorting, Chiropody etc, for up to date charges please refer to the Residents Information Pack.



Questions & Answers

Some frequently asked questions:

Q. Can I bring my own furniture?

A. Yes, if there is space for it in your room, please feel free, we want you to feel right at home!

Q. Can I smoke?

A. Unfortunately not, Auchtermairnie is a non smoking establishment.

Q. Do I have a choice of meals?

A. Yes, off-course you do as you would in your own home, meals are prepared and cooked by our own experienced staff, there is always a choice from the menu. Special diets

and vegetarians are also catered for.

Meals are served in the dining areas and you can have tea or coffee in your room at anytime, day or night.

Q. Is my laundry taken care off?

A. Yes, all laundry is done on the premises and is usually returned to you within 48 hours, I can't promise we won't lose a sock now and again, but you would expect that at home as well!

Q. What are the visiting times?

A. Anytime you or relatives want! It is your home, relatives and friends are most welcome.

Q. Can I keep my own doctor?

A. If he or she agrees, then yes, if this is not possible through issues of location etc, we can arrange for you to be registered with our own medical practitioner, other services such as opticians, dentists etc can be arranged as and when required.

Q Do I have anything else to pay for?

A All aspects of care and accommodation are included in the weekly fee's, only extras like hairdressing / newspapers / Escorting need be paid for.

Q Are there any activities?

A Yes there is a monthly activities plan with regular events throughout the year.

Q Can I bring a pet?

A Depends on the pet and other circumstances at the time, each request will be considered.
